MATHEMATICS

- Count, compare and order numbers to 1,000.
- Explore partitioning using different manipulatives and variety of ways to represent numbers.
- Add and subtract up to 4-digit numbers.
- Explore lengths and comparing units of measure.
- Multiply and divide numbers by 1, 3, 6, 7, 9 and 10.
- Children will be given ample opportunities to use a variety of resources to explore the units this term and investigate different ways to represent their responses.

ENGLISH

Non-Fiction: Pupils read about Neil Armstrong in an interactive e-book. They work towards writing a diary entry and a biography.

Fiction: Pupils start by listening to 'Christophe's story'. In the main writing task, children write their own stories, drawing on their own personal experiences and a shared model text.

SCIENCE

- Understand that all living things can be sorted into groups and classification keys can be used to identify which living thing goes in which group.
- Use the terms macro and micro habitat and be able to identify these in our local environment, using field work skills.
- Realise that food chains live in these and that they can be affected by environmental changes.
- I describe the functions of the organs in the human digestive system.
- Identify and describe the different types of teeth in humans.
- I construct food chains to identify producers, predators, and prey.

Humanities: The Great American Road Trip

This unit travels the North and South American continents, and distinguishes between the terms 'continent', 'country', 'state' and 'city' along the journey. Finding and using images and maps on the internet, children will make notes on cities and record their States. They will compare the built environments and settings of the cities and, through them, identify some key regions of the American continents.
