MATHEMATICS

Place Value

Recap: counting forwards and backwards within 20, tens and ones within 20, counting forwards and backwards within 50, tens and ones within 50, compare numbers within 50.

Count objects to 100 and read and write numbers in numerals and words; represent numbers to 100; ten and ones with a part-whole model; tens and ones using addition; use a place value chart; compare objects; compare numbers; order objects and numbers; count in 2s; count in 5s; count in 10s; count in 3s

Addition and Subtraction

Fact families- addition and subtraction bonds to 20; check calculations; compare number sentences; related facts; bonds to 100 (tens); add and subtract 1s; 10 more and 10 less; add and subtract 10s; add by making 10; add a 2 digit number and a 1 digit number crossing ten; subtraction crossing ten

SCIENCE

Science - Animals, including humans

- Describe the basic needs of animals, including humans for survival
- Describe the importance for humans of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food, and hygiene
- look at animal young and comparing them to their adults
- look at how animals change as they grow up and be introduced to the life cycles of several varied common animals, including humans.
- look in detail at how humans change as they grow older, drawing on their own observations.
- Children are introduced to the three basic needs of animals for survival (water, food and air).

ENGLISH

Non-fiction – All about Orangutans

In this unit, the children explore the Big Question: Could you keep an orangutan as a pet? They will read the interactive eBook All About Orangutans, asking questions and collecting facts. They will research other animals in 'expert groups' and present their findings. Pupils will learn about imperatives and how they are used in commands and instructions, writing their own instructions to tell someone how to care for a pet. In the long writing task, they design and write their own mini non-fiction book or report.

Poetry – Silly Stuff

In this unit, the children explore poems with themes and language that are funny and engaging. They experiment with sound and pattern as they recite and perform their poems. They create, edit and evaluate stanzas and poems based on models.
