MATHEMATICS

Multiplication and Division

We will continue looking at multiplication and division in the context of applying times tables to formal methods. We will introduce multiplying and dividing 2-digit numbers by 1-digit numbers.

Money

We will apply place value knowledge to understanding how to convert between pounds and pence. In addition, we will look at adding and subtracting money. Children will also explore giving change.

Statistics

We will look at the different ways in which data can be presented i.e. bar charts, tally graphs, pictograms and tables. Children will also think about interpreting data from the above.



ENGLISH

Non-chronological report

We will recap the features of a non-chronological report, in the context of writing a report about the death of Tutankhamen. We will recap features such as headings, subheadings, captions and a glossary.

Diary Entry

We will write a diary entry to describe the discovery of Howard Carter. Children will explore the structural and grammatical features of a diary before writing their own.



PSHE

This unit, entitled 'It's My Body', explores the choices children can make about looking after their bodies. The lessons look at making safer choices about their bodies, sleep and exercise, diet and cleanliness. Children will learn facts about each of these areas and learn strategies on how to manage them.

COMPUTING

Learners will be introduced to desktop publishing software.



ART

In this Unit, children will create Art pieces inspired by their Ancient Egyptian topic. They will revise the use of oil pastels and how blending techniques can be used to create varied effects. They will also think about how to use design criteria to plan a design and evaluate their design throughout the making process. They will also evaluate their final pieces of work and make suggestions for improving their methods.

SCIENCE & HUMANITIES

In Science, children will understand the importance of the right type and amount of nutrition as well as the functions of skeletons and muscles. They will understand that plants and animals obtain food in different ways, identify the right types and demonstrate they understand the right amounts of nutrients for animals including humans. In addition, we will identify and categorise animals based on the type of skeleton it has. Children will identify the main bones in the body and how a skeleton protects, supports and helps the body to move.

In our humanities unit, the children will explore who the Ancient Egyptians were, what they did, and discuss whether Ancient Egypt deserves its reputation as one of the most important early civilisations. Children will also make comparisons with what was happening in Britain at the same time, linking back to prior learning in Year 3. We explore why the achievements of the Ancient Egyptians should be regarded as so significant. Additionally, sources of evidence will be evaluated, with discussions as to what they tell us about the Ancient Egyptians. Finally, children will collate everything they have learnt to reflect on what was the greatest achievement for the Ancient Egyptians.
