## MATHEMATICS

## ENGLISH

### Non fiction:

#### Save Pompeii

In this unit, the children go on an imaginary mission back in time to warn the people of Pompeii about the volcanic eruption. They read the interactive eBook, locating key information in the text and creating an action plan. The writing tasks include creating an information leaflet and writing a non-chronological report using formal language.

### Poetry:

In this unit, the children explore free verse poems, focussing in depth on the work of two poets. They focus on imagery and explore different language patterns. They write poems based on a model and present a free verse poem in letter form.

### Grammar:

- Know what synonyms and antonyms are
- Use vocabulary typical of formal writing (abstract nouns)
- Understand the concept of abstraction
- Use and understand the terms 'subject', 'verb' and 'object'
- Revise the characteristics of spoken language
- Use adverbial links instead of co-ordinating conjunctions to open sentences
- Use adverbial links added to 'and' between main clauses
- Recognise differences between formal and informal texts
- Recognise extremely formal language, including the subjunctive

The children will link their History studies of who the Ancient Greeks were with this DT unit. They will observe Greek pottery and make **detailed observations while drawing carefully**. ## SCIENCE & HUMANITIES

### Science:

In this '**Light**' unit, the children will learn about **how we see shadows, reflection and refraction**. They will learn how light travels and how this enables us to see objects. This will be demonstrated with the children having the opportunity **to make a periscope, use mirrors to observe reflection and working scientifically to investigate refraction**: carrying out some fascinating experiments into effect of bending light. Furthermore, they will learn about **Isaac Newton and his theory of light and colours**.

They will explore the UK's trade links today and in the past, finding out about goods imported and exported and the methods of transport used. Through a more detailed look at one of the UK's trade partners, the children will learn about the benefits of trading internationally, as well as the risks to this area.
