Nursery has been learning about 2D shapes, and has been doing lots of art work on shapes.

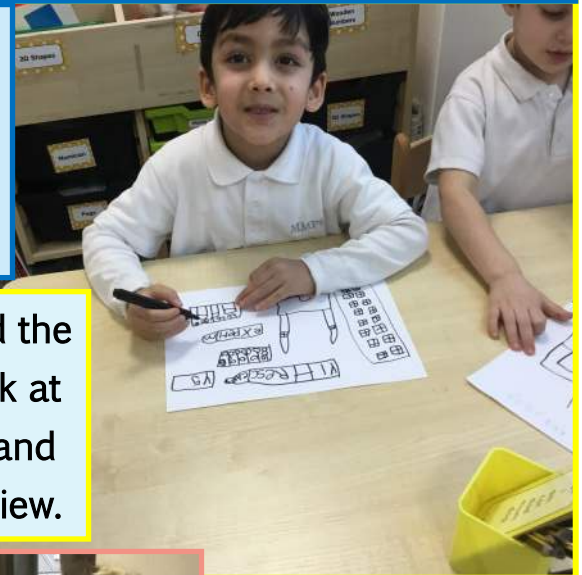


Year 5 created posters about old age and debunked some myths about the elderly!
