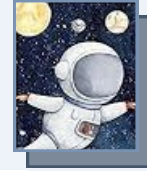

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

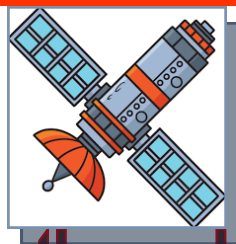


Using characters from books, we will investigate confidence and resilience. We will also be looking at how to resolve conflicts and persevere and communicate our feelings when facing challenging.



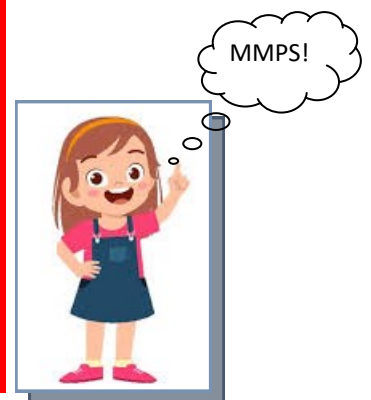
Physical Development

Pupils will learn to travel in a variety of ways including using equipment and develop greater confidence kicking, passing and throwing balls.



Communication and Language

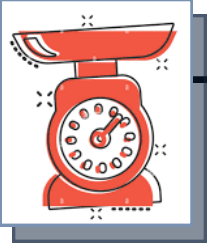
Pupils will be taught to engage good speaking and listening skills when working with partners on 'space station' challenges. They will be encouraged to use connectives like 'because' when explaining and to use new vocabulary such as lunar rover, gravity when roleplaying.





Mathematics

The class will continue to deepen their understanding of numbers to 8 by practising to subdivide, learning to notice different groupings and memorising number facts. They will answer questions addition and subtraction questions such as 'What is 1 less than... Can you total these 2 groups.' Pupils will also explore ways of measuring, using scales, talking about time and when events occur.



Understanding the world

Reception will be exploring our new school and looking at maps and globes including satellite images and aerial photographs/videos. They will be introduced to the solar system and learn about our planet. Pupils will also discover who Helen Sharman and Tim Peake are, and conduct some of their own experiments.

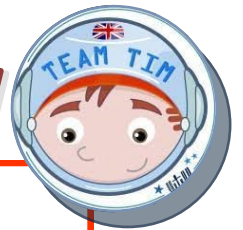


Expressive Art and Design

We hope to make space inspired art using a variety of medias and materials



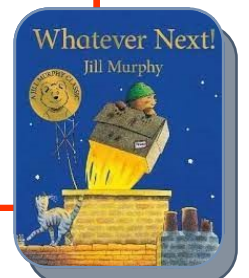
Phonics and Literacy

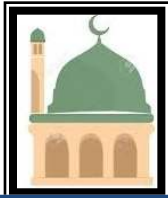


This term the Pupils will continue to learn phase 3 sounds such as **ai ee igh oa oo** [in 'moon' and 'look'] and learn to read tricky words: **my, by, you, they, all**. Reception will also try to memorise phase 2 high frequency words so that they can recognise the words instantly and don't need to blend them [A, an, as, if, in, is, it, of, off, on, can, dad, had, back, and, get, big, him, his, not, got, up, mum, but, put.]



Reception will be comparing and contrasting space themed story books by the author and illustrator Oliver Jeffers and also Jill Murphy. The class will be encouraged to anticipate events and then once familiar with the texts to retell the stories using words from the text. We will also examine fact books about Space including a biography about British astronaut Helen Sharman. The children will be given opportunities to write space themed captions and speech bubbles for astronauts and aliens they discover in the books we read. Together they will recall new information they've learned and help an adult to write some space facts.
