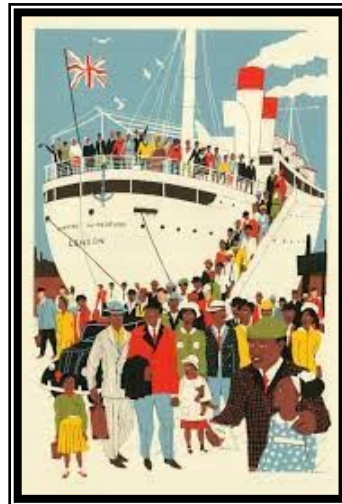
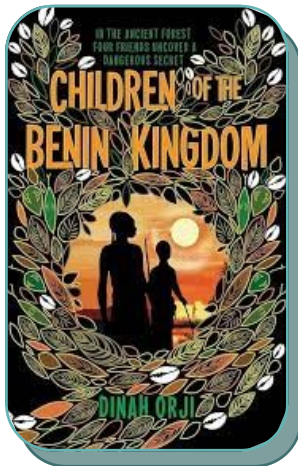

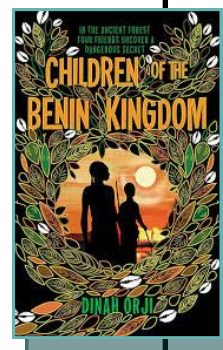
**Theme**



**Exciting Explorations**



In our English unit, Year 5 will be exploring the book: 'Children of the Benin Kingdom' by Dinah Orji. The book follows the story of Ada, who discovers her true identity and must travel into the heart of the rainforest to heal the divisions that are occurring within the kingdom. Through the sequence of learning, children will explore the story from various perspectives, comparing characters and writing letters and diary entries in role. They will offer advice taken from warnings given and discover the meanings of new words within the context of the story.



# English

# Maths

In our Spring multiplication topic, Year 5 will move onto using a formal method for multiplication, by building on their knowledge from Autumn 2. They will also practise using a formal method for division, and investigate dividing with remainders.



We will begin our fraction topic, exploring areas such as equivalent fractions, fractions greater than 1, improper fractions, mixed fractions and multiplying fractions. Children will build on their knowledge of times tables, multiplication, division and repeated addition when investigating fractions.

# Computing

## Online Safety

In this unit, children will learn about email safety with a focus on preventing and dealing with spam. They will consider the importance of strong passwords and learn how to create them. Children will build on their knowledge of plagiarism and fair use of people's work by learning how to write citations and references for websites they may use. They will scrutinise photographs that they see online and learn how easy it is to manipulate pictures and present them as reality.



# Science

In our Science unit, the children will learn about the life cycle of a human being. They will investigate the development of babies and compare the gestation period of humans and other animals. The final investigation will be about the changes to humans as we get older, as well as comparing the life expectancy of different animals.



# History

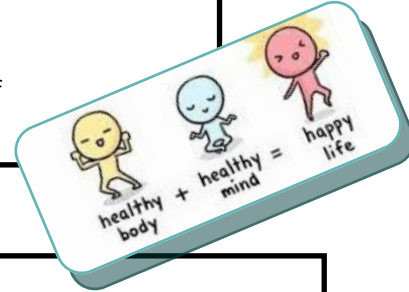
In our History unit, the children will explore the question of why people go on a journey and look at four very different types of journey in depth. The children begin by studying the voyage of the Irish 3rd class passengers on the Titanic, before learning about the Kindertransport in World War Two and the voyage of the Empire Windrush. Finally, they will examine why refugees make dangerous journeys today. Children will develop their chronological understanding, and differentiate between journeys made by choice and journeys necessary for survival.



# PHSE & RS

In this PSHE unit of work, children will learn about how to take care of their bodies. This will involve learning about body image and stereotypes and learning about substances which are harmful to our bodies. Children will also learn about the importance of sleep, exercise and hygiene. Throughout the unit, children will be encouraged to consider the choices they have, healthy habits that can benefit us all and how to seek support should they need to.

This RS unit discusses the concept of commitment in both religious and non-religious ceremonies and daily life. By giving examples of commitments made by famous figures, it encourages children to make their own goals and invites them to review their commitment each week throughout the unit. Children also explore the concept of sacrifice and why sacrifices may be made.

In our Art unit, 'The Seaside' the children will learn how to use pen and colour, how to print and weave to create quality artwork that shows progression in skills. The children will also have the opportunity to explore the work of 'The Seaside' artists Alfred Wallis and Hokusai.

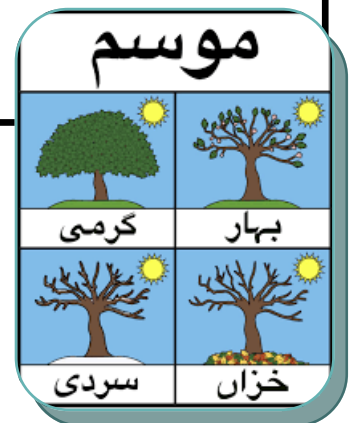
