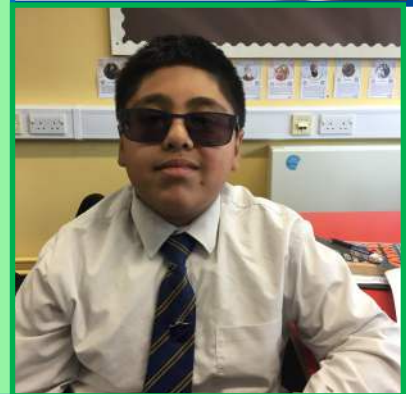
## After School Clubs
