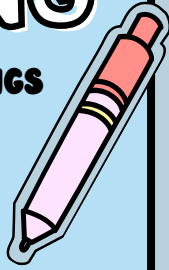

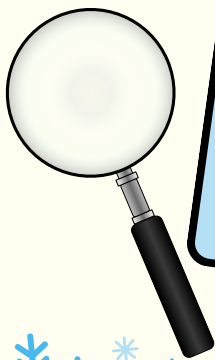


Highlights of the Week

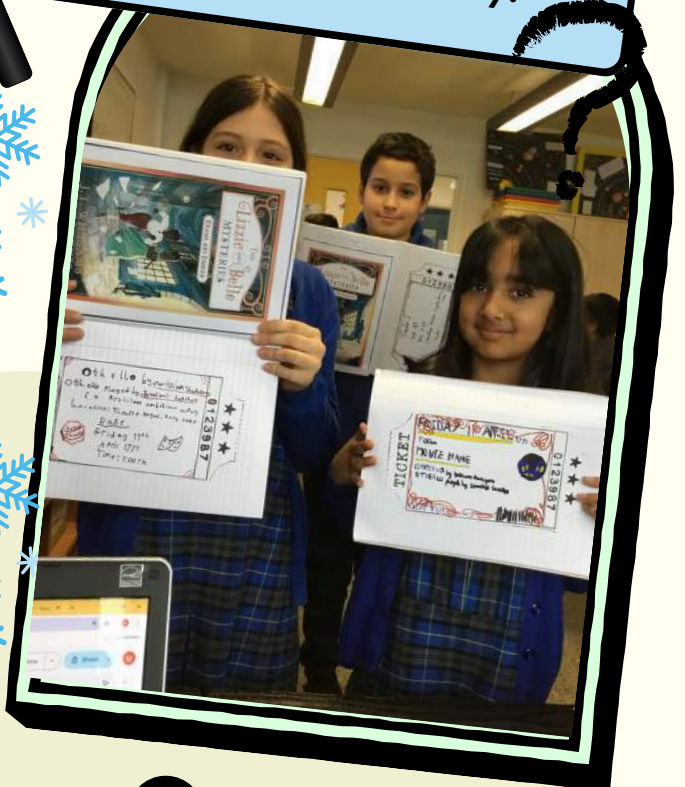


Reception and Nursery had a great time playing in the snow. They had fun on the sledge, and threw snowballs – even at Miss Grant!
