

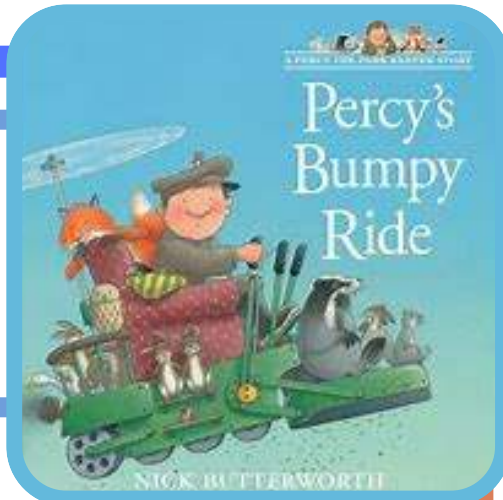
# TOPIC LIST- RECEPTION

## LITERACY

## PE

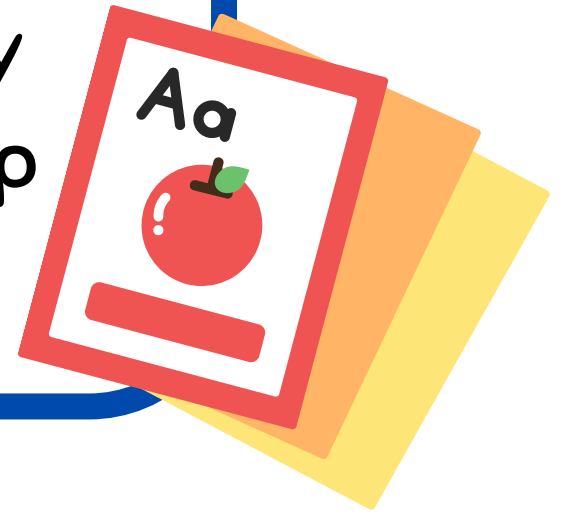

# COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE

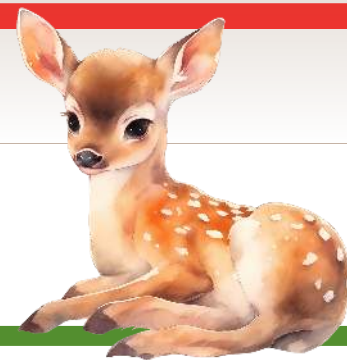
Reception children will endeavour to extend their vocabulary and use the new vocabulary in their play and when making up narratives or writing sentences.

## PERSONAL, SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT

We will be talking about good deeds we can do during Ramadan to help our parents and our community. We will continue to talk about our feelings and ways to self regulate.



## UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD

The class will begin the half term by reading the Percy Park keeper book 'After the storm' and reflect on which animals' habitat is the oak tree, and what they would do if they were the park keeper after a storm, Pupils will have opportunities to reenact the story or make up their own alternative versions using the woodland creatures and props in the roleplay area. Pupils will also be learning about the importance of keeping their teeth cleaned and eating healthily, and will be practising using toothbrushes on fake plaster casts of teeth.

During Ramadan, the whole school will be looking at an element of the seerah. Reception will be learning about the revelation of the Quran in the cave at Mount Hira. So we will look at footage of the cave and compare it to caves around the world and also learn about the ways people in the past used to record information before they had paper readily available.





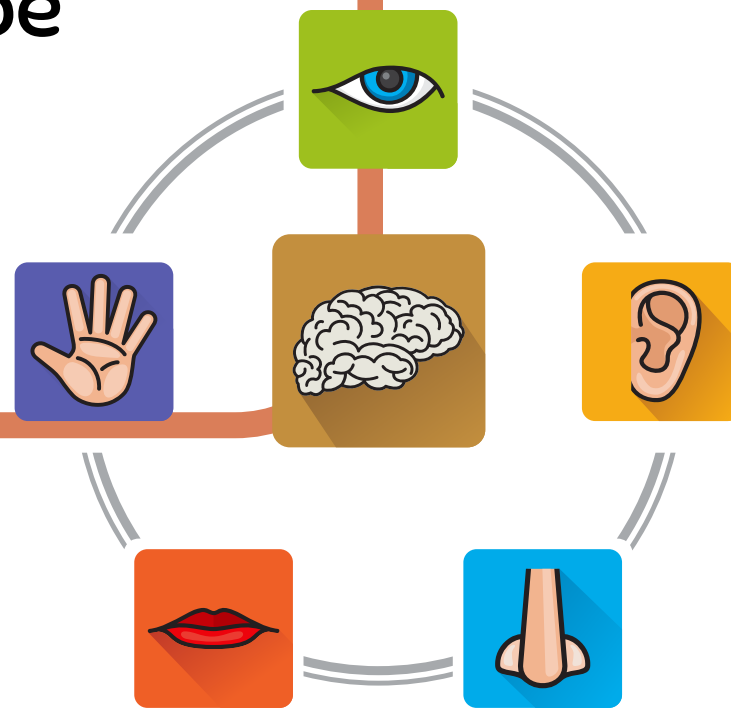

Memorisation: surah Surah Quraish
