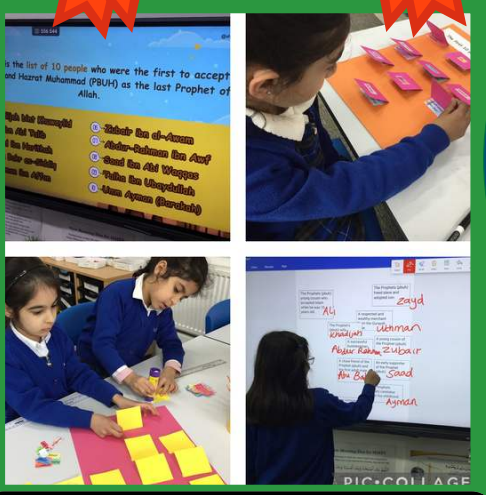

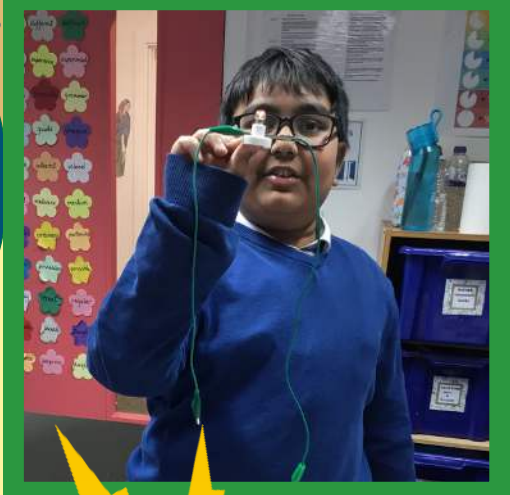
IDENTITY

Reception have been dressing up as dentists and practising brushing off 'chocolate and sugary treats' from their pretend teeth using the proper technique.

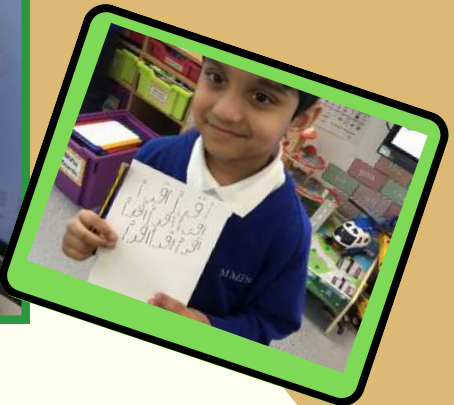
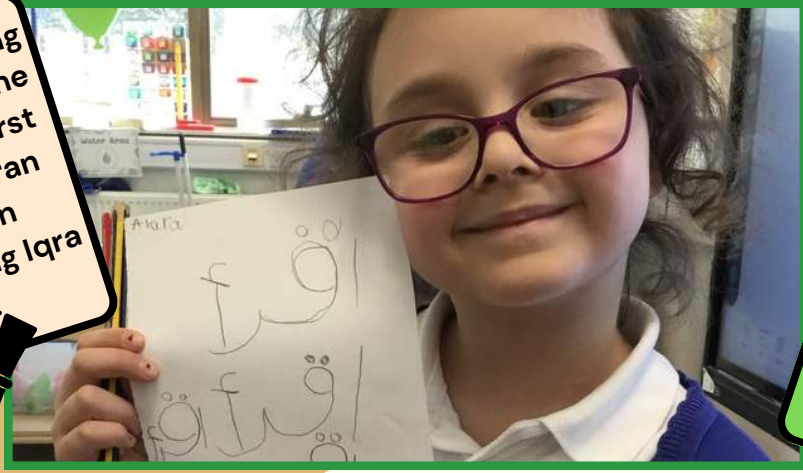
## RECEPTION CLASS
