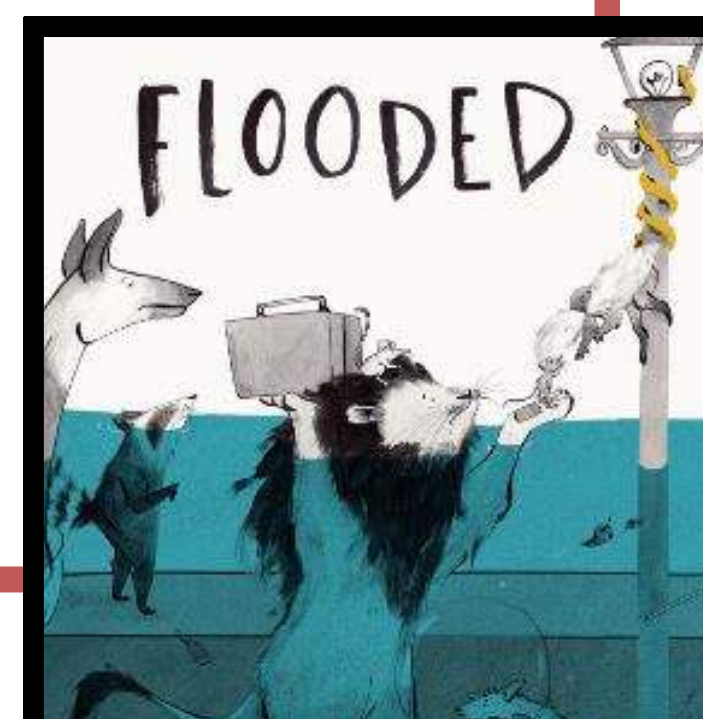
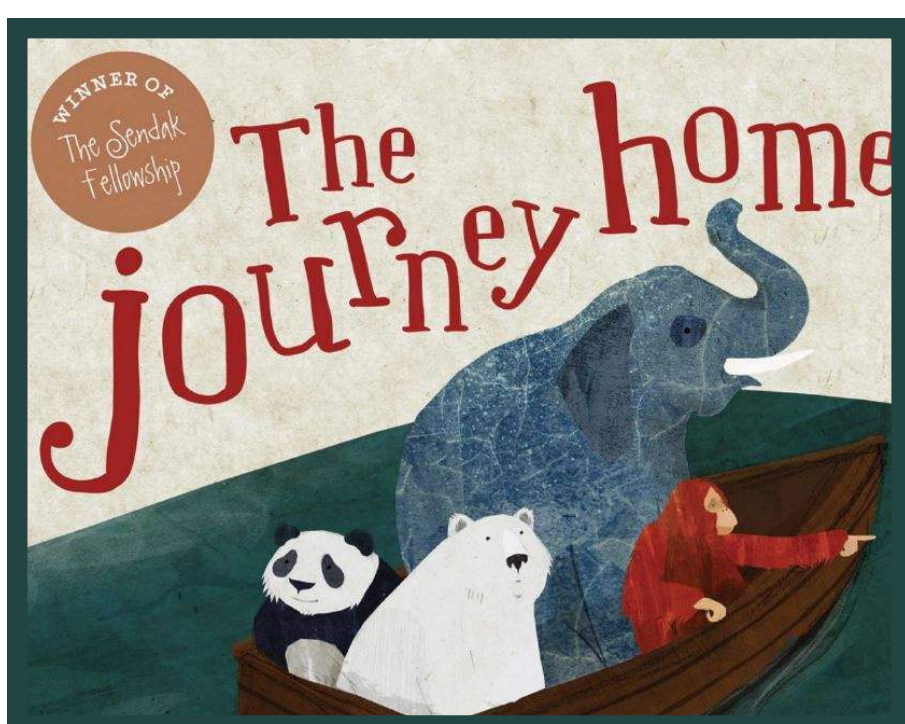


FLOODED - MARIAJO ILUSTRAJO

Where does our food come from?

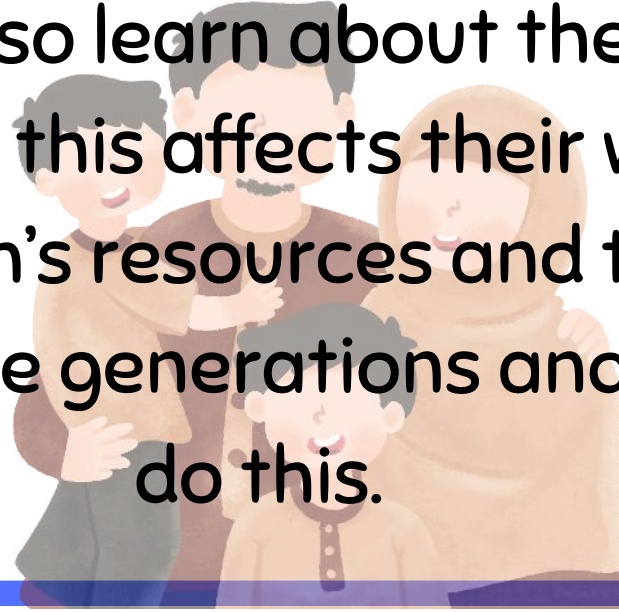

There is a strong element of local area study with a suggested farm, market and shop visit to begin to show the class the connections between the food we buy and how much of it comes from the UK.





One World

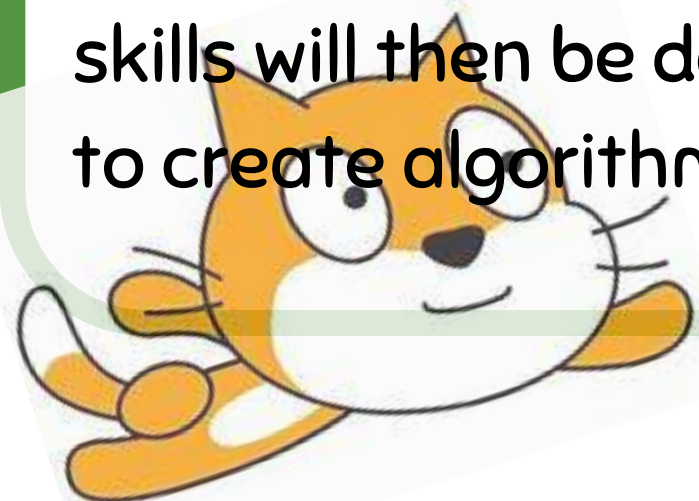
This unit is inspired by the idea that we can benefit from learning about people living in different places to us and their ways of life. It aims to enable the children to explore their own family life, home and school and compare these to children's family life, homes and school from around the world which are different from their own. In this unit, children also learn about the relationship between people and their environment and how this affects their way of life. They will also learn about how people use the earth's resources and the importance of protecting the earth for ourselves and future generations and how we can work together to do this.



COMPUTING

Programming Turtle Logo and Scratch

This Programming Turtle Logo and Scratch unit will teach the children to create and debug algorithms. The children will learn to use the basic commands in Logo to move and draw using the turtle on screen, and then further develop algorithms using the "repeat" command. These skills will then be developed by teaching children to create algorithms in Scratch using a selection of blocks.
