Assalamu alaikom.

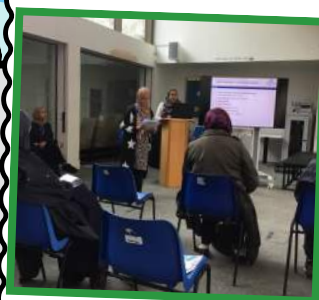

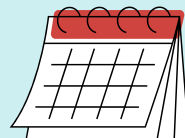

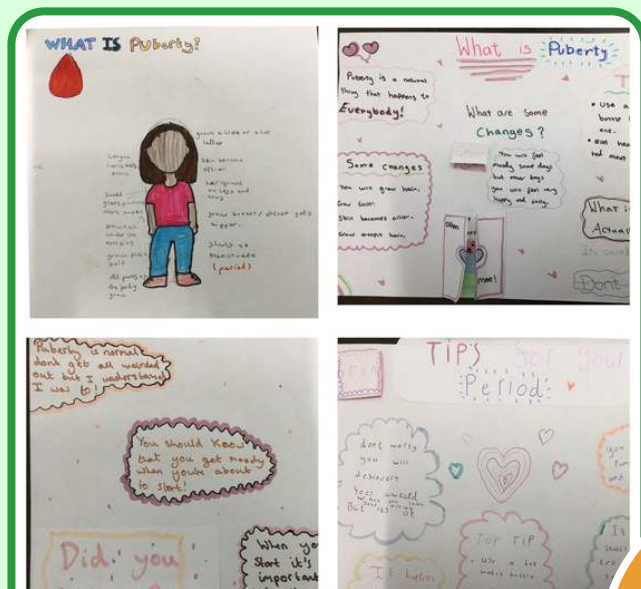


Some Year 3 pupils took part in filming for the Global Rahmah Foundation, helping to raise money for Gaza

Boys and girls in Year 5 and 6 had separate sessions, learning more about the changes as they grow up.



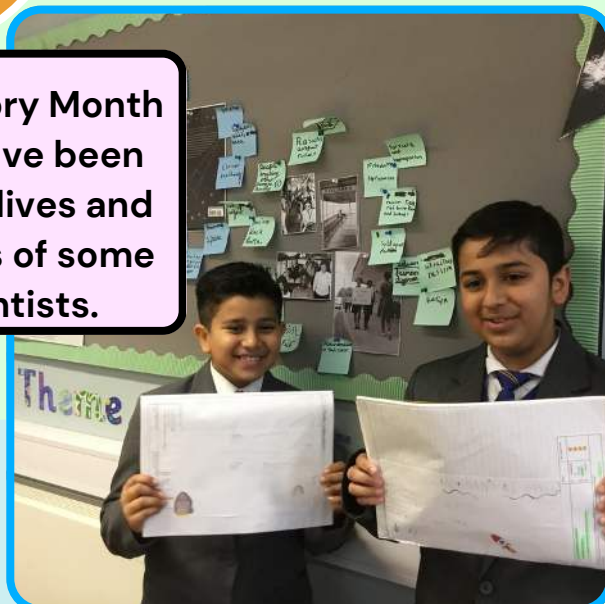
MIGSG students delivered their own presentation all about life at their school.
