Year 3 created art notebooks with artist Tobi who delivered an art workshop.

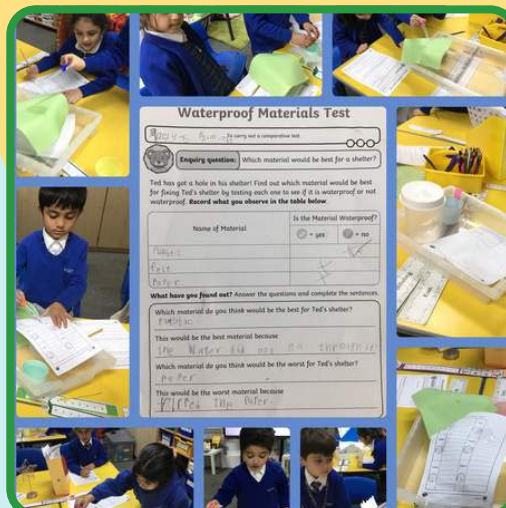


Assemblies this week focussed on National Braille week. Pupils tried decoding some words in Braille and learnt about the impact of sight impairment.
