All the classes out did themselves with the exhibits they produced for the Quran Exhibition.

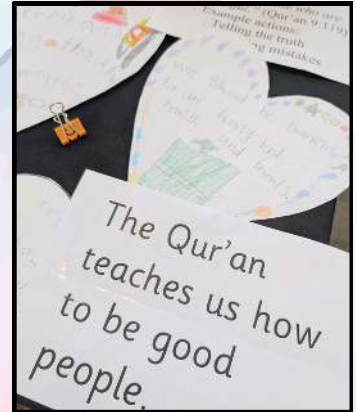
Year 5 produced some amazing artwork around the theme of Prophets in the Quran and Quran facts quizzes.
