Physical Education (PE) Teacher

Job Title: PE Teacher
Responsible To: PE Lead / Headteacher

Job Purpose:

To plan, deliver and assess high-quality Physical Education lessons across Key Stages 1 and 2, promoting physical literacy, healthy lifestyles, teamwork and a lifelong enjoyment of sport and physical activity. The post holder will contribute to the continued development of PE across the school, including extracurricular provision, competitive sport and whole-school wellbeing within a positive Islamic ethos.

Key Responsibilities:

- Plan and deliver engaging PE lessons in line with the National Curriculum.
- Adapt teaching effectively to meet the needs of all pupils, including those with SEND, EAL and differing physical abilities.
- Promote physical development and encourage pupils to lead active and healthy lifestyles.
- Organise and oversee extracurricular sports provision, including one after-school club, enrichment activities and intra/inter-school competitions.
- Assess, monitor and report on pupils' progress and attainment in PE, using assessment information to support future learning and development.
- Ensure inclusive practices so all children, regardless of ability, enjoy and benefit from PE.
- Ensure all PE activities are carried out safely and in line with school policies, safeguarding procedures and health and safety requirements.
- Work collaboratively with class teachers and teaching assistants to support cross-curricular initiatives and whole-school wellbeing.
- Manage and maintain PE equipment and resources.
- Contribute to the wider life of the school, including school trips, events and themed days.
- Promote high expectations of behaviour, teamwork, respect and sportsmanship in all PE activities.
- Promote positive attitudes towards participation, teamwork and healthy competition across the school.
- Take responsibility for promoting and safeguarding the welfare of children and young people within the school.

Other

- To have professional regard for the ethos, policies and practices of the school in which you teach, and maintain high standards in your own attendance and punctuality.
- Perform any reasonable duties as requested by the Headteacher.
- Attend all after-school meetings or, where part-time, attend meetings on agreed working days.
- Attend end-of-year celebrations.



The duties and responsibilities in this job description are not exhaustive. The postholder may be required to undertake other duties that are in line with the purpose and grade of the role, as directed by the Headteacher. This includes complying with any reasonable request to support the effective operation of the school

Essential Requirements:

- A strong commitment to safeguarding, wellbeing and pastoral care
- Qualified Teacher Status (QTS) in the UK.
- Experience teaching PE in a primary school setting.
- Strong knowledge of the PE National Curriculum (KS1 to KS2).
- Excellent communication and organisational skills.
- A passion for sport, fitness and children's development.

Desirable:

- First Aid qualification.
- Experience organising school sports competitions.
- Knowledge of inclusive PE strategies and adaptive sports.
- Experience leading or supporting extracurricular sports clubs and enrichment activities.
